



2026 REPUBLICAN PRIMARY ELECTION INSTRUCTIONS

**All ballots must be received by 8 PM on Election Day, June 23rd.
Postmarks are not counted if received after 8 PM on Election Day.**

You have received your ballot for the Primary Election scheduled for June 23, 2026.

Your ballot has been prepared for automated counting. Any unnecessary marks or erasures may cause your ballot to be rejected. If you make a mistake, spoil, or damage your ballot, contact us for a replacement.

Select the candidates using a black or dark blue ink pen. Do NOT use a marker. Mark the oval in front of the

candidate.  Do not vote for more than allowed, or that race will not be counted. Refold the ballot as it was received. Do NOT make other folds. Fill out and SIGN the affidavit on the back of the return envelope.

THE AFFIDAVIT MUST HAVE A SIGNATURE FOR THE BALLOT TO BE COUNTED.

WE VERIFY EACH SIGNATURE.

Be sure you sign the affidavit on the envelope with your name. It is illegal to sign for another voter, even with their permission. Do NOT detach the affidavit, or the ballot may be rejected.

Attach postage and mail the completed ballot to the County Clerk's Office. As an alternative to mailing, you may drop your ballot off in one of four 24-hour ballot boxes located at each town office. See location details below.

VOTING IN PERSON - If you prefer to vote in person, you may vote at the Early Voting Center in Randolph or at Election Day Voting Centers in Randolph and Garden City.
