**RESOLUTION OF RICH COUNTY TO REAPPLY
FOR ANOTHER FIVE-YEAR DESIGNATION AS
AN ENTERPRISE ZONE**

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone Act, Utah Code Ann. § 63N-2-201 et seq. authorizes the Governor's Office of Economic Development to designate qualifying areas to be "enterprise zones;" and

WHEREAS, Rich County is currently designated as an enterprise zone; and

WHEREAS, the Rich County Board of Commissioners sees a real need to continue to promote economic development and sustainable wages in Rich County; and

WHEREAS, the current designation's five-year term expires soon; and

WHEREAS, the Rich County Board of Commissioners desires to reapply for another designation term;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Rich County Board of Commissioners will seek to have the Governor's Office of Economic Development re-designate unincorporated areas of Rich County as an "enterprise zone" pursuant to the Enterprise Zone Act.

This resolution shall be effective on the date it is adopted.
