**RESOLUTION OF RICH COUNTY REQUESTING  
THE RECERTIFICATION OF THE RICH COUNTY  
JUSTICE COURT**

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of Utah Code Ann. § 78A-7-103(1)(b) require that justice courts be recertified at the end of each four-year term; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of the Rich County Justice Court shall expire in January of 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Rich County Board of Commissioners has received an opinion letter from the Rich County Attorney, which sets forth the legal requirements for the operation of a justice court and the feasibility of continuing to maintain the justice court; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Board of Commissioners have determined that it is in the best interests of Rich County to continue to provide for a justice court.


**BE IT RESOLVED**, the Rich County Board of Commissioners hereby requests that the Board of Justice Court Judges and the Utah Judicial Council recertify the Rich County Justice Court for another term.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Rich County Board of Commissioners hereby affirms its willingness to continue to meet all requirements set forth by the Judicial Council for the continued operation of the Rich County Justice Court for the next four-year term of court, except as to any requirements waived by the Utah Judicial Council.

This resolution shall be effective on the date it is adopted.
