**RESOLUTION TO ORDER A MORATORIUM ON PETITIONS TO DEVELOP RV
PARKS AND CAMPGROUNDS IN UNINCORPORATED RICH COUNTY**

WHEREAS, development of campgrounds and RV Parks requires approval from the County Planning and Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, approval requires compliance with the County's Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the County's Development Code does not specifically address RV parks or campgrounds, which causes them to fall under the provisions for subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, it would be more appropriate to address campgrounds and RV parks not as subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission needs 90 days to review and address this issue; and

WHEREAS, a short moratorium on petitions to develop campgrounds and RV parks is in the County's best interest.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Rich County Board of Commissioners orders a ninety (90) day moratorium on petitions to develop campgrounds and RV Parks beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County's Planning and Zoning Commission shall not accept applications to develop campgrounds or RV parks while the moratorium is in place.

This resolution shall be effective on the date it is adopted.
