A RESOLUTION OF THE RICH COUNTY COMMISSION TO
AUTHORIZE THE IMPOSITION OF A 0.30% LOCAL OPTION
SALES AND USE TAX TO FUND PUBLIC SAFETY UNDER
UTAH CODE SECTION 59-12-2216

WHEREAS, Rich County is authorized to impose a local option sales and use tax to fund public safety under Utah Code § 59-12-2216 (2024); and

WHEREAS, the Rich County Commission finds that there is an ongoing and special need to better fund public safety in the county; and


WHEREAS, the Rich County Board of Commissioners finds that the imposition of this local sales and use tax would be in the best interests of and promote the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of Rich County;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Rich County Board of Commissioners resolves as follows:

1. The Commission approves the imposition of a three-tenths of one percent (0.3%) sales and use tax within Rich County as set out in Utah Code § 59-12-2216. This county option sales tax will apply to all transactions described in Utah Code § 59-12-103(1) within the county, including within the cities and towns in the county.
2. One hundred percent of these sales and use tax revenues will be allocated to fund public safety purposes.
3. The intention of the County Commission is for this resolution to be sent to the Utah State Tax Commission to have the tax commission apply this tax as soon as allowed by Utah Code § 59-12-2209.
